**RE: Operational Advisory – Fire & Medical Service Change for 2012**

Medical and Fire Services for the Project will be integrated into Site Security Services effective February 1<sup>st</sup> 2012. This change aligns Project Services with industry standard medical/fire services and will result in improved performance of services and a significant reduction in the overall cost of services.

Specific changes include: a service model using one EMT/Firefighter per shift while continuing **24/7** coverage; immediate ambulance call for all serious medical situations (billed to the patient if the patient accepts medical transport); immediate call to the local fire service provider (Rural Metro) for any fire situation requiring such service (billed to Common Services Expense).

Please note that there will be no change to the method in which Occupants report any fire or medical incident to Site Security.
